Financial and Innovation Assistance under SSIP 2.0 Policy – Government of Gujarat

In alignment with the Student Startup and Innovation Policy (SSIP 2.0) of the Government of Gujarat, A.D. Patel Institute of Technology (ADIT) is committed to fostering a culture of innovation, research, and entrepreneurship among students. To facilitate this, the institute has established a dedicated Student Startup and Innovation Cell to provide comprehensive support to students with innovative ideas.

Under SSIP 2.0, students are eligible to receive financial assistance for the development of Prototypes (PoC), Proof of Concept (PoC), and Innovations. The policy also offers mentorship support, infrastructure facilities, and IP (Intellectual Property) support to help students transform their innovative ideas into tangible products.

Key Benefits Under SSIP 2.0:

- **Financial Assistance:** Up to INR 2.50 Lakh per Proof of Concept (PoC) / Prototype / Innovation.
- **IP Support:** Up to 100% financial assistance for expenses incurred towards filing patents, copyrights, or other forms of Intellectual Property.
- **Mentorship Support:** Guidance from industry experts, faculty members, and innovation facilitators to nurture innovative projects.
- **Infrastructure and Facility Support:** Access to technical resources, labs, and infrastructure to facilitate prototype development.

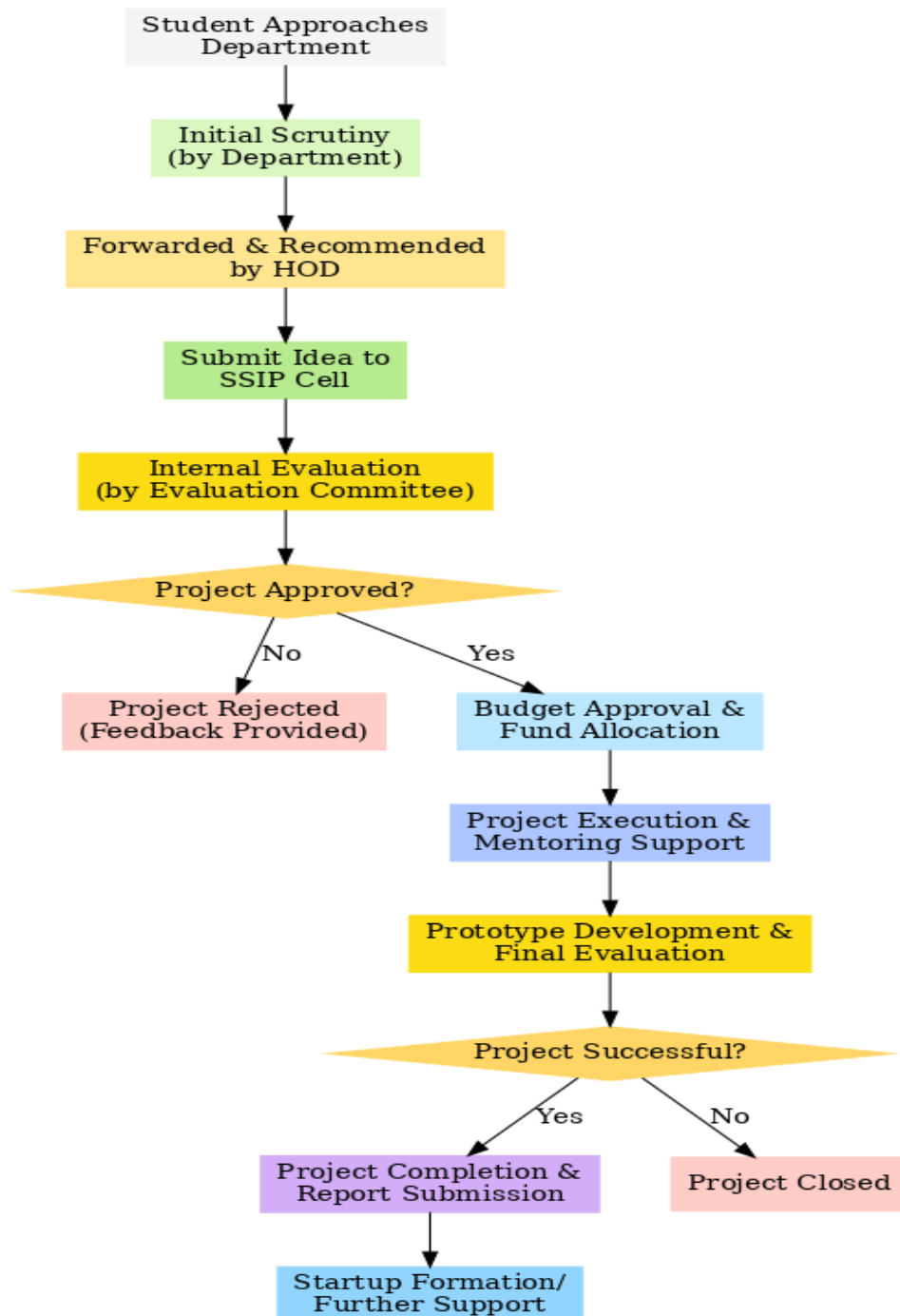
Application Process:

The submitted proposals will undergo a structured evaluation process, and the selected innovative ideas will receive financial and technical support as per SSIP 2.0 guidelines.
