## Scholarship Policy (2026-2027 Onwards)

*Effective from: Academic Year 2026-27*

### **A. Preamble**

At The Charutar Vidya Mandal (CVM) University, we are committed to fostering academic excellence, inclusivity, and equal opportunity. The CVM University stands as a beacon of transformative education rooted in the values of academic brilliance, equity, and social inclusiveness. Through a comprehensive and evolving scholarship framework, the university seeks to reward scholarly merit, uplift marginalized communities, and recognize student achievements from diverse backgrounds in achieving their educational goals.

This policy outlines the principles, eligibility criteria, and processes governing the awarding of scholarships funded by the university, alumni, donors, and external partners. It is designed to ensure transparency, fairness, and accountability in the administration of scholarship programs. Through this policy, the university aims to attract and retain talented individuals who demonstrate academic promise, leadership potential, and a commitment to making a positive impact in their communities. It also ensures that the distribution of scholarship funds aligns with the strategic goals and values of the university.

We believe that investing in our students' potential not only transforms individual lives but also enriches our academic community and society at large. This policy serves as a guide for all stakeholders involved in the scholarship process.

### ***Types of Scholarships and Detailed Criteria: -***

The CVM University offers various categories of scholarships which may be merit-based, need-based, or awarded for specific talents, fields of study, sports or contributions to the community.

#### **1. Meritorious Student Scholarship**

This scholarship is granted to students who exhibit sustained academic excellence through the marks/grades scored in the previous class/ institution i.e. Senior Secondary/ Graduation/ Post Graduation before taking admission in the university. **(Only at time of admission in regular mode)**

#### **2. Single Girl Child Scholarship**

In support of gender parity and to promote education for girls, this scholarship is awarded to a female student who is the only daughter in her family. Applicants must provide valid proof such as a ration card or other certified documentation confirming single girl child status.

#### **3. Ward of Martyr Scholarship**

Bestowed in tribute to the supreme sacrifice of martyrs from armed or paramilitary forces, this scholarship supports their wards. Applicants must present valid death certificates and service credentials and maintain the requisite academic standards without backlogs.

#### **4. Defence/Army Personnel Ward Scholarship**

Children of active or retired defence/paramilitary personnel are eligible under this category. The student must hold a valid service certificate or Ex-Servicemen ID as proof.

#### **5. National/State-Level Sports Scholarship**

Awarded to students with commendable achievements in sports at national or state levels within the last two years. Continued university representation is mandatory for renewal. Validated participation certificates are required during application and annual renewal.

#### **6. National/State-Level Cultural Scholarship**

For those who have represented their region or state in cultural domains such as music, dance, drama, or art. The student must participate in university cultural events as a precondition for continued support. Official certification from organizing bodies is essential.

#### **7. Physically Challenged (Mobility Disability) Scholarship**

Designed to support is meant for students with physical disabilities, especially those with spinal cord injuries or visual impairments. To qualify, applicants must have a medical certificate showing at least 65% permanent disability and, in the case of visual impairment, an official blindness certificate issued by the government."

#### **8. CVM Managed Institutions Alumni Scholarship**

Students who have completed their previous educational program from any CVM-run school or college qualify under this scheme. Submission of final mark sheets or leaving certificates is required for verification.

#### **9. Ward of CVM Faculty/Staff Scholarship**

Offered to children of CVM University employees. Documentation must include a valid Employee ID and a Bonafide certificate issued by the parent institution or HR department.

#### **10. Girl Child from the Charutar Region**

The Charutar Girl Child Empowerment Scholarship is designed to assist girl students specifically from the Charutar Region, covering Anand and Kheda districts.

#### **Scholarship Cancellation/ Discontinuation**

The sole purpose of the Scholarship is to promote and reward scholarly merit, uplift marginalized communities, and recognize student achievements from diverse backgrounds in achieving their educational goals. However, noncompliance to the academic standards, involvement in Unfair means cases, involvement of anti-social activities, unacceptable conduct and inconsistent performance in academics, sports, cultural and extracurricular activities will lead to cancellation/ discontinuation of the scholarship as and when found guilty or applicable. The following are the probable criteria's but not exhaustive. The Scholarship committee may consider other circumstances/ situations at appropriate time as and when appears. *The decision of the management of the university shall be the final in all respects whether to continue/ discontinue the student's scholarship or not.*

#### **1. Academic Criteria**

- Less than 75% attendance in each course. (theory, tutorial and Practical separately)
- Failing in any course or subject/ No backlogs.
- Incomplete academic progress or delayed completion.
- Change in Course or Program
- Switching majors or programs without approval.
- Dropping out of a full-time program or converting to part-time (in PhD program Only)
- Not completing the program within the stipulated scholarship period.

#### **2. Behavioural and Disciplinary Reasons**

- Any sort of Disciplinary Action initiated against the student.
- Involvement in academic misconduct (e.g., plagiarism, cheating).
- Breach of institutional code of conduct or ethical guidelines.
- Criminal charges or legal violations.
- Misrepresentation or Fraud
- Providing false information during the application to admission.
- Forged documents or credentials.
- Prolonged absence without valid justification.
- Lack of Engagement/ Not participating in mandatory activities (e.g., research, community work, internships, university events).

#### **3. Financial and Administrative Grounds**

- Change in Financial Status
- Family or personal income exceeds the defined threshold (for need-based scholarships).
- Failure to Submit Documentation as valid proofs or submission of wrong/ misleading documents.
- Missing renewal forms, progress reports, or required documents.
- Violation/ Not adhering of Scholarship Conditions
- Accepting another scholarship without approval (dual funding issue).
- Withdrawal/ Dropout or Voluntary Withdrawal
- Students voluntarily leave the institution or scholarship program.
- Transfer to Another Institution
- Moving to a different college or university without proper clearance.

#### **4. Sports and Cultural**

Students applied and admitted under such scholarships by The Charutar Vidya Mandal (CVM) university must have to represent/ play in State/ National/ International events/ competitions in this category. If the students fail to do so their scholarship may automatically stand cancelled.

- Please note that The Charutar Vidya Mandal (CVM) university reserves the rights to revise the scholarship policy at its discretion from time to time as and when required.

- The Charutar Vidya Mandal (CVM) University statutory bodies reserve the right to modify, revise, or update the criteria for scholarship eligibility as and when required, based on prevailing academic, administrative, or policy considerations.
- Only one scholarship benefit among the mentioned schemes will be applicable to a student at any given time, and the scholarship with the higher value will be granted.

### **General Rules and Scholarship Disbursement**

- Eligible students may be granted a **Meritorious Student Scholarship** at the Time of Admission (First Year only) on the annual tuition fee, as per university norms.
- Once the student will make payment of **full annual tuition fee** the sanctioned scholarship amount shall be **credited to the student's bank account** after verification and approval by the competent authorities.

#### **1. Exclusion Clause**

- Students receiving any **Government Scholarship** or any scholarship other than the University Scholarship shall **not be eligible** for the University Meritorious Scholarship benefit.
- Dual scholarship benefits are strictly **not permitted** under any circumstances.

#### **2. Approval & Verification Process**

Scholarship disbursement shall be subject to detailed verification and approval by:

A Scholarship Committee shall be constituted in each Institute/College as per the following standard composition:

##### **Composition**

- **Dean, Students' Welfare** – Chairperson
- **Head of the Institute/Principal/Director** – Member
- **One Senior Faculty Member (nominated by the Head of Institute)** – Member
- **Representative from Accounts Section** – Member
- **Scholarship/Academic Section Officer (Institute level)**– Member Secretary

The Committee shall function in accordance with University policies and approved scholarship guidelines.

##### **Step-by-Step Process**

**Step 1:** Committee review and recommendations are documented in the Committee Minutes.

**Step 2:** The recommendations are forwarded to the Accounts Department.

**Step 3:** The Accounts Department verifies the fee structure and outstanding dues.

**Step 4:** The approved scholarship percentage/amount is reviewed as per the Policy.

**Step 5:** Compliance with financial norms is checked.

**Step 6:** Final approval is accorded through the Registrar's Office.

### **3. Record Maintenance & Reporting**

- The Accounts Department shall maintain:
  - Student-wise records
  - Institute-wise records
  - Year-wise scholarship details
- A consolidated list of scholarship awardees shall be submitted to:
  - IQAC & ERP
  - Respective Schools/Departments for cross-verification


